### General Meeting

- III. Treasurer's Report read by Treasurer, Nancy Squires.
- IV. Concession Notes: Need volunteers to work at all games that include RMS, Jr. Varsity and Varsity. Mr. David Estes has agreed to work the grill during the Jr. Varsity games. Mr. Vincent Spencer has agreed to work the grill during the RMS Games. Andrea Locke, concession chairperson stated that the one cash drawer work good but this is based only on the pre-season game.
